



Clayton Vale - Facilities



The Centre

Located on Edge Lane (opposite the Bay Horse Public House). The centre is only open to the public at events. However, if the door is open please feel free to come in and use the facilities including toilets and cafe at certain events. Picnic Areas

There are a number of picnic areas around the site. The ones nearest the centre are more accessible to the disabled.



Natural Play

There are no formal play areas at present on Clayton Vale but it is a fantastic place to explore! Run through the long grass and use your imagination to create your own play space, the natural environment is a great place to do this.

There are a number of paths with different walks, lots of green space and wooded areas offering lots of open space for running and playing. Let your imagination run wild!



Angling



Fishing is available at the Fishing Pond near the Iron Bridge. Please ensure you put all rubbish in appropriate bins provided or take it home. Leaving lines and bags can be damaging to the environment and the local wildlife. The fishing pond is a Site of Biological Importance due to the Common Reed growing there which is not common in the local area.

Ponds

There are two SBI's (Sites of Biological Importance) ponds including the fishing one. The other is near Culcheth Lane near the railway. The reason for them being declared SBI's is they have Common Reed within the ponds which is a plant that is not common to the area. Reed beds are one of the UK habitat priorities.

Near the centre is a pond which is used for dipping during events and with schools and the hidden pond is located near the Iron Bridge.
